There are teams working in each council area within the Northern Health and Social Care Trust. In emergency situations, a crisis response service will link with out of hours GPs or the emergency department (ED)

Community outreach

Provides a service for people with severe and enduring mental health problems who require intensive support in the community

The Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service (CAMHS)

Provides specialist multi-professional support in the community for children and young people aged up to 17 years experiencing mental health problems

The dementia service

Provides assessment, support and treatment for people in a range of settings who have dementia. The service also links with a number of voluntary and community organisations that provide support and respite in the community for the patient and their carer
